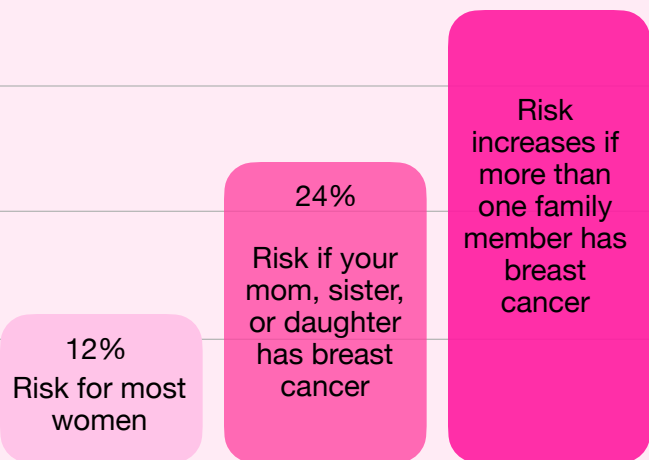

Breast Cancer Risks Depend on Family History

Finding Cancer Early Improves Outcomes

When breast cancer is found early **98** out of 100 women survive

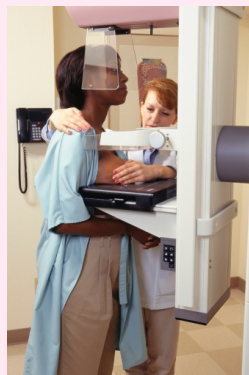
If cancer is found late (after it has spread) only **28** out of 100 women survive

How to Find Breast Cancer Early

- Mammograms and breast MRIs are screening tools that can help catch breast cancer earlier when it is easier to treat
- Insurance usually covers screening costs
- For women with a family history of breast cancer, doctors often recommend:
 - Starting screening at a younger age
 - Screening more often than women at average risk
